
**BID PROTEST:**

Such Notice of Intent to Challenge shall be filed in writing at the following address: Government Services Group, Attn: Tammy Peters, 1500 Mahan Dr Ste 250, Tallahassee, FL 32308, **within 72 consecutive hours** after posting of this Notice of Intent to Award. Protestor shall thereafter be required to file a formal written procurement challenge within 5 business days of the posting of this Notice of Intent to Award. Protestors must consult the Highway 79 Corridor Purchasing Policy for required information that must be included in the Notice of Intent to Challenge and formal written procurement challenge and for the applicable procurement challenge bond that must be submitted along with the written procurement challenge. Failure to file a Notice of Intent to Challenge and formal written procurement challenge along with the appropriate procurement challenge bond within the timeframes provided herein shall constitute a waiver of all rights granted under the Hwy 79 Corridor Authority Purchasing Policy.


